


RED GINGER



Camarones, Argentina

This rugged Patagonian outpost is all about its surrounding flora and fauna. The rocky coasts, majestic mountains and panoramic views feel far from the bustle of city life, giving the town an easy sense of calm. Particularly of note, a Magellanic penguin colony thrives at Cabo Dos Bahías, a nearby nature reserve southeast of Camarones. The rookery is home to a large population of nesting penguins in the spring and summer, and you'll spot marine birds, sea lions, fur seals, rheas, foxes and guanacos yearround. Fishing is the lifeblood of the town, so angling adventures are a top choice as are whale- and dolphin-watching outings. Don't miss the chance to dine on the local seafood.

Champagne Bay (Espiritu Santo), Vanuatu

Situated within the Vanuatu archipelago in the remote South Pacific, Champagne Bay is home to the eponymous beach known to be one of the most beautiful on the island of Espiritu Santo. Named for the spring-fed bubbles that rise to the surface during low tide, the bay is the perfect place to loll, swim, drink, eat and repeat. Or you might want to check out nearby Port Olry farther north,

which has another excellent beach with multiple restaurants right on the shore. For more excitement, head south to Luganville or try an adventure like shipwreck diving, trekking to Millennium Cave or kayaking through one of the island's astonishing Blue Holes.

Edinburgh of the Seven Seas, Tristan da Cunha

The world's most remote permanent settlement, Tristan da Cunha is a volcanic island surrounded by the South Atlantic Ocean. Less than 300 islanders and visitors reside on the island, so the remoteness guarantees tranquillity along with one-of-akind experiences. Dotted with a variety of homes and buildings, the village offers insight into the traditions and way of life on this far-flung island. Tristan da Cunha will take your breath away due to not only its setting but also the incredible community that lives here. Hiking opportunities abound and it is a naturalist's paradise - the archipelago is a globally significant breeding site for seals and millions of seabirds.

Fernandina Beach, Florida

Located on lush Amelia Island, Fernandina Beach is a historical bayside town with loads of Victorian charm. The town's historic district boasts more than 50 blocks of buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places with 450 of the beautifully preserved homes built before 1927. You'll want to take your time exploring as the streets are lined with some of the country's finest examples of Queen Anne, Victorian and Italianate buildings. Kilometres and kilometres of pristine beaches and nature reserves stretch out around Fernandina Beach, offering plenty of opportunities for hiking, biking and horseback riding. History lovers won't want to miss nearby Fort Clinch State Park, home to one of the United States' best preserved Civil War-era forts.

Hambantota, Sri Lanka

Off the beaten path on the southern edge of Sri Lanka, Hambantota reveals verdant beauty, ample culture and incredible biodiversity. It's a gateway to several stunning national parks and wildlife sanctuaries. Yala National Park is a top choice for its sheer variety of wildlife - you might spot elephants, leopards, sloth bears and more. The UNESCO World Heritage site of Galle is also accessible from Hambantota - the 18thcentury walled Old Town features charming Dutch architecture and possesses a beguiling, exotic ambience that enchants travellers. Mirijjawila Botanical Garden, located in the dry zone, features a dazzling spectrum of rare and endemic plant species.





Hillsborough (Carriacou), Grenada

Did you know Grenada is composed of several islands? Carriacou, which means "Isle of Reefs," is the laidback little sister of the main island of Grenada and offers a taste of old Caribbean charm. It's remained one of the Caribbean's delightful hidden secrets with its beautiful beaches and mangroves though it's just a 90-minute ferry ride from the main island. While spanning only 34 square kilometres, Carriacou is rich in history. The small but significant Carriacou Museum, housed in an old cotton factory in Hillsborough, reveals the island's native, African and European influences. Nautical connoisseurs will want to head to Windward, where traditional wooden Carriacou sloops are still built using the techniques of early Scottish settlers.

Hitachinaka, Japan

Hitachinaka is in one of the quieter parts of the Ibaraki Prefecture northeast of Tokyo. This region is known for its beauty, which can be enjoyed any number of ways. Drive to nearby Mount Tsukuba, where you can go on an easy hike on the walking trails or take in the views from a cable car that travels partway up the mountain. For a more adventurous day, try bungee jumping off the Ryujin Suspension Bridge, a 366-metre-long pedestrian bridge over a lake nestled between tree-covered hills about an hour away from Hitachinaka. For a longer road trip, make your way through the countryside to fantastic Tokyo, about two hours away by train.

Hualien, Taiwan

Known as the main gateway to Taroko National Park, easy-going Hualien offers plenty of its own attractions, but the surrounding natural beauty has a way of stealing the limelight. It's hard to ignore the soaring marble valleys, cascading waterfalls, suspension bridges and mountain vistas that await in the nearby national park - not to mention the largest marble canyon in the world. Those who prefer to stay in town might visit the Hualien Railway Culture Park for a look at the history of train travel in Taiwan; Gangtiangong, an immense Matsu temple with lavish shrine rooms; and the peaceful Martyrs' Shrine, dedicated to soldiers who died during the Chinese Civil War.

Isla de los Estados, Argentina

Arriving at the bottom of the world, you will be welcomed by rugged landscapes, epic scenery and diverse wildlife that very few have the opportunity to experience. Considered part of the Tierra del Fuego province and located at the entrance of the Beagle Channel, Isla de los Estados has been designated an ecological reserve. The island is an excellent location for whale watching - you're likely to spot orcas, along with sea lions, seals and Magellanic penguins on boating excursions and shoreline explorations. History buffs will enjoy Estancia Harberton, which has been declared a National Historical Monument and sheds light on some of the earliest European settlers and how they interacted with the local indigenous community.

Kupang (West Timor), Indonesia

As Indonesia is known as the land of laughs and smiles, the people of West Timor will delight you with their welcoming nature. In Kupang, the capital of West Timor, you're likely to notice influences from the Dutch and Portuguese colonial eras when Kupang was an important trading post. Visit the Museum of Nusa Tenggara Timur to discover artefacts from the province and insights on the city's legacy and historical occasions in the region. Natural wonders are plentiful too. Crystal Cave is a stunning attraction named after its clear water, and jungle-shrouded Oenesu Waterfall is a favourite among locals and travellers alike. Lovely beaches are nearby as well - try Lasiana for its white sand and calm waves or Pantai Tedis to watch the sun set and enjoy local Indonesian fare.





Puerto del Rosario, Canary Islands

Puerto del Rosario, the capital of the island of Fuerteventura, offers an endless array of white beaches and blue water. Warm weather year-round makes this destination the perfect paradise for beach lovers. Take a stroll around the city and view the beautiful murals and artworks, or visit one of the nearby picturesque hamlets, such as El Cotillo, to discover the slower pace of local life. Head inland to explore the island's surreal volcanic and desert landscapes. The former capital town of Betancuria is an excellent location to delve into the island's history, and the surrounding roads also offer some of the best viewpoints on Fuerteventura. With its designation as a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, outdoor adventures on Fuerteventura won't disappoint.

St. Helier (Jersey), Channel Islands

Given its favourable tax status, Jersey at first glance appears to be an excellent place to shop – and it is. But there is much more to this beautiful British island only 21 kilometres from the French coast. Amid more than 250,000 years of human history, you can find one of Europe's oldest structures nestled under a medieval chapel and learn about the role the island and its inhabitants played during the German occupation of World War II. With a mild climate similar to its neighbours on both sides of the English Channel, the island offers the best of France and England in the form of lavender and wine as well as excellent dairy and local produce.

Takamatsu, Japan


The largest city on the island of Shikoku, Takamatsu is fondly known as "Udon Kingdom," thanks to its status as the unofficial udon capital of Japan. Try sanuki udon, the local variety of thick wheat flour noodles available with a variety of broths, sauces and savoury accoutrements. Ritsurin Koen, one of the most beautiful gardens in Japan, is the perfect place to walk off lunch - bridges, koi ponds, islands and tearooms grace the 185-acre garden that dates to the 17th century. Takamatsu Castle Ruins and Takamatsu City Museum of Art are also top choices in the city. Easily accessible by ferry are the beautiful islands of Seto Inland Sea. such as the art haven of Naoshima.


Waingapu (Sumba), Indonesia

One of the more undiscovered islands of Indonesia, Sumba is the adventurer's dream where time seems to stand still. It's a place of lagoons, wild horses, tropical forests, celestial waterfalls, soft white sand beaches and intriguing tribal culture. Life in Sumbanese villages unfolds according to the rhythms and rituals of Marapu, an animistic faith, and the guidance of local shamans. In villages outside of Waingapu, you'll spot traditional bamboo houses with thatched roofs and megalithic tombs and gain insight on the well-preserved culture. You're also likely to observe a handweaving technique known as ikat, which creates exotic fabrics for which the island has become known. Sumba just might be Indonesia's best-kept secret.
